Freedom Writers, a 2007 American film starring Hilary Swank, Scott Glenn, Imelda Staunton and directed by Richard LaGravenese, is adapted from the book *The Freedom Writers Diary* written by teacher Erin Gruwell based on her real experience.

It's a movie concerning multiracial culture, ethnic conflicts, idealism versus realism, education and redemption, love and sacrifice.



The movie was set in 1994 in Long Beach, California when the idealistic white lady Erin Gruwell was just starting her first English-teaching job at Woodrow Wilson High School, which, two years earlier, implemented a voluntary integration program. Compared with other white teachers complaining about the school's ruined reputation because of the program, Erin Gruwell believed that every student has equal right to get the best education regardless of their colors. Although she gradually found that it's too utopian to teach them arts and literature, which were seemed to be pointless when they were got bogged down in struggling to live amid ceaseless gang violence, Erin still stuck to her own belief: books could change a person, a generation, even a whole society.

So she adopted special methods to reform her beloved students who were initially hated her but finally respected and loved her. Those methods including honing them a habit of writing diary, offering them new books such as The Diary of Anne Frank, bring them to the Holocaust Memorial and having dinner with the survivors. The most touching part lies in the

sacrifice Gruwell chose to make. She gave up her personal freedom to do two part-time jobs at the same time so as to earn enough money to cover the expenditure of books and extra activities; and the lack of company with her husband ultimately gave rise to their divorce. Overall, however, the film rings true about the magic a dedicated teacher can do with rebellious but malleable teens. Her students finally realized how influential they could be in advocating harmony among races.

As Sidney Hook put it, "Everyone who remembers his own educational experience remembers teachers, not methods and techniques. The teacher is the kingpin of the educational situation." towards those who still toil in the fields of education, gratitude would never be too late to express.
